DDOT addressed the projected traffic volumes in our March 22, 2019 staff report to the BZA. Given the number of residential units (approximately 108), low vehicle parking supply (approximately 32 spaces), and the agreed to TDM Plan, we determined that the site-generated peak hour traffic volumes would be relatively low and did not warrant further analysis of the transportation network. Additionally, the Applicant has committed to work with DDOT in public space permitting to implement a new crosswalk across Evarts Street, which should increase safety for pedestrians. As such, DDOT re-iterates our recommendation that the BZA approve of this application with the conditions noted in our report. Please let me know if you have any further questions or comments.
