ORDERED:

That the order of the Commissioners, D. C., prepared on April 29, 1965, and published in accordance with the requirements of Public Law 307, approved December 15, 1932, is hereby issued and promulgated with respect to Item 4 of said order, and the street areas shown on plat filed in the Office of the Surveyor of the District of Columbia are hereby ordered CLOSED, effective June 21, 1965, and thereafter, as set forth in said prepared order and publication, the title to the land comprised in said areas so closed to revert to and/or vest in the abutting property owners as shown on said map; the said areas so closed being described as follows:

(4) Closing of 2nd Street, S. E., between I and M Streets; of L Street, between 2nd and 3rd Streets; and providing for transfer of jurisdiction for the widening of I, K, M and 2nd Streets. (File S. O. 64-467)

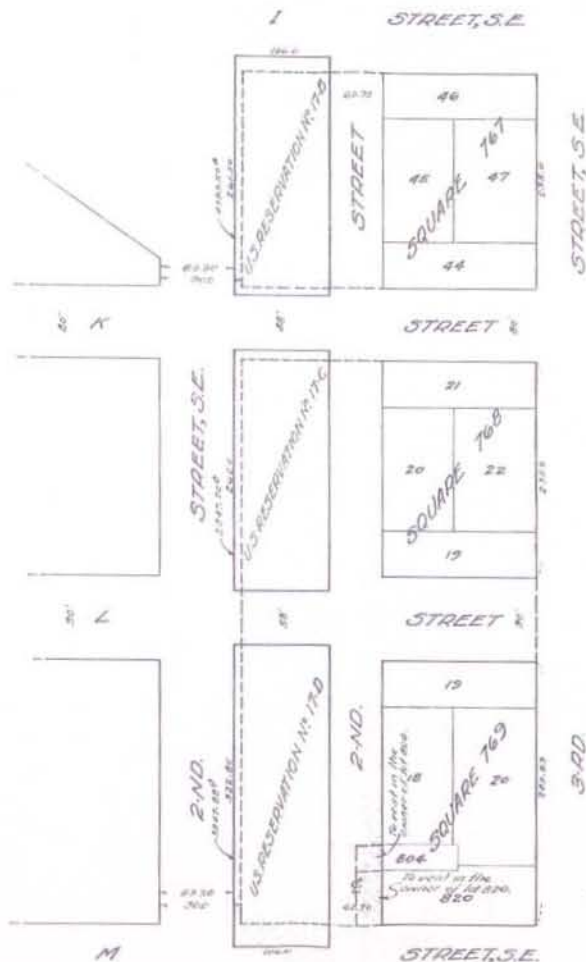
