

party wall

party wall *n* : a wall which divides two adjoining properties usu. having half its thickness on each property and in which each of the owners of the adjoining properties has rights of enjoyment : a wall on or near the boundary line between adjoining owners and owned by them in common or in severalty or by one owner alone and providing mutual rights of support for the respective adjacent buildings or structures

par-u-la \ 'par(y)ələ\ *n, cap* [NL, fr. L *parus* titmouse + *-ula*]

: the type genus of Parulidae including the parula warblers
parula blue *n* : a grayish blue that is redder and paler than electric, greener and paler than copenhagen, and redder and lighter than Gobelin

parula warbler *n* : a small grayish blue American warbler (*Parula americana*) of eastern No. America having an olive-green patch on the back

paru-lid \ 'par(y)ələd, pə'rül-\ *adj* [NL *Parulidae*] : of or relating to the Parulidae

parulid *n -s* : a bird of the family Parulidae : WOOD WARBLER

pa-ru-li-dae \ pə'rülə,dē\ *n pl, cap* [NL, fr. *Parula*, type genus + *-idae*] : a family of small bright-colored passerine birds containing the American warblers — see WOOD WARBLER

pa-ru-lis \ -ləs\ *n, pl paruli-des* \ -lə,dēz\ [NL *parulid-*, *parulis*, fr. Gk *paroulid-*, *paroulis*, fr. *para-* ¹*para-* + *-oulid-*, *-oulis* (fr. *oulon* gum); prob. akin to Gk *eilein* to wind, roll — more at VOLUBLE] : an abscess in the gum : GUMBOIL

par-umbilical \ (ː)par+\ *adj* [ISV ¹*para-* + *umbilical*] : near the umbilicus; *specif* : being any of several small veins that connect the portal and epigastric veins

pa-rure \ pə'rū(ə)r, -üə\ *n -s* [F, lit., adornment, fr. OF *pareure*, fr. *parer* to adorn, *prepare* + *-ure* — more at PARE] : a matched set of jewelry or other ornaments worn together (a ~ of emeralds including a necklace, bracelets, earrings, and tiara)

par-us \ 'pa(a)rəs\ *n, cap* [NL, fr. L, titmouse] : the type genus of Paridae comprising various common titmice

parv- or parvi- also **parvo-** *comb form* [L *parv-*, *parvi-*, fr. *parvus*; akin to Gk *pauros* small, slight — more at FEW] : small (parvanimity) (parvifolious) (Parvobacteriaceae)

par-va \ 'pärvə, 'pävə\ *n -s* [NL, fr. L, fem. of *parvus* small] : a late larval stage of shrimps of the tribe Carides

par value *n* : ¹PAR 1b

par-va-nim-i-ty \ ,pärvə'niməd-ē\ *n -ES* [*parv-* + *-animity* (as in *magnanimity*)] : the quality or state of having a little or ignoble mind : MEANNESS — opposed to *magnanimity*

parve *var of PAREVE*

par-ve-nu \ 'pärvə,n(y)ü, 'päv- also ==\ *n -s* [F, fr. *parvenu*, past part. of *parvenir* to arrive, fr. L *pervenire*, fr. *per* through + *venire* to come — more at FARE, COME] : one that has risen (as by the acquisition of wealth or power) above the station in life in which he was born; *esp* : one that is unaccustomed to his new station or that makes great pretensions because of his acquired wealth : UPSTART (loudmouthed ~s who took care to obtain great publicity for their charitable works — Leslie Charteris) (the gentry may be the ~s of a few generations back — Roy Lewis & Angus Maude)

par-ve-nu or par-ve-nue \ " \ *adj* : newly risen to position

paschal sacrifice *n, son*

pa-schen-back effect \ Friedrich *Paschen* †194 cists] : a limiting stage the magnetic field causing the extremely fine structure or less complicated and normal triplet character

paschen's law *n, usu c* statement in electronic electrodes in a gas is a function and the pressure so that must be halved

pas-co-ite \ 'paskō,īt\ *n* central Peru + E *-ite*] : of a hydrous calcium vanadate

pas-co-la \ 'päs'kōlə\ *n* old man of the fiesta] : and Yaqui Indians who lesques and clowning troupes

pas-cu-al \ 'paskyüəl\ *n* to feed, pasture) + E *-al* growing in pastures

pas d' ac-tion \ 'pädä:'s action step] : a pantomimic dramatic scene in a ballet

pas-d'âne \ 'pädän\ *n, p* ring-shaped guard on each 16th and 17th centuries

pas de basque \ 'pädə-\ *n, p* step] : a dance step alternating counts that is characteristic

pas de bourrée \ 'pädə-\ *n, p* step] : a sideways ballet step or in front of the other

pas de chat \ 'pädə'shə\ *n, p* : a catlike forward leap in a ballet

pas de che-val \ -shə'val\ *n, p* step] : a ballet step resembling a horse's step

pas de deux \ -'dō, -'dör, step for two] : a dance for two

pas de trois \ -'trwə\ *n, pl* : a dance or figure for three

pa-se \ 'pä(,)sə\ *n -s* [Sp, 3d sing. pres. subj. of *pasar* — more at PASS] : a mo drawing a bull and taking

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
