The Board's order did not contain any erroneous findings of fact or conclusions of law. As a small business man serving the Washington D.C. community since 1986, I am disheartened by the ANC's actions against my business. The new business owner has been operating nicely in good faith ever since receiving the Board's decision. The whole appeal process has cost me dearly both financially and emotionally. I urge the Board to stand by the solid decision it reached and to uphold it's order. I therefore you to deny the ANC motion.
