Advisory Neighborhood Resolutions & Letters

- **Summary of ANC-1D library resolutions through December 2008**
- **February 2009: ANC-1C passes resolution asking DCPL for inclusion & updates**
 - * DCPL responds, May 2009
- **March 2009: ANC-1D's passes a collaborative community library resolution**

This resolution was shaped by the community in attendance and seeks a renovation-only plan for the Mount Pleasant Library
- **June 2009: ANC-1D summer library resolution seeking some more answers about the project**
- **September 2009: ANC-1C seeks a halt to the project if certain outreach expectations are not met**
 - * DCPL responds to ANC-1C Resolution, October 13, 2009
 - * ANC-1C seeks clarification, November 12, 2009
 - * December 22, 2009 response from DCPL sheds little light
- **December 2009: ANC-1D passes a resolution to contract for technical studies on the MtPl Library design plans**
- **January to April 2010: ANC-1C contracts with a local Universal/ADA expert to review DCPL's plans**
 - * **ANC-1C passes a resolution and transmits it to the City Council and DCPL which asks for abatement of problems regarding DCPL's proposed plans as noted in expert findings**
- **April 2010: ANC-1A backs up ANC-1D and ANC-1C in their expectations that DCPL respond to the expert findings**
