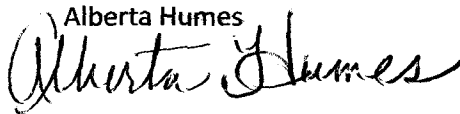
Dear Mr. Weinbaum,
