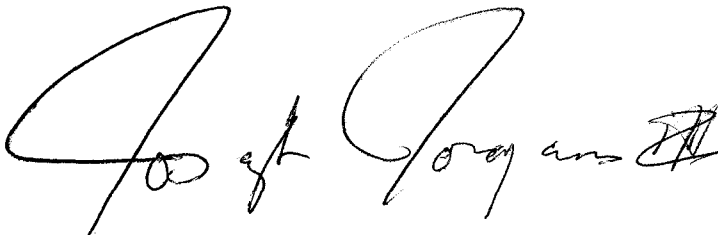
Dear Mr. Nero:
