Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-309.10 (b), the Board of Zoning Adjustment (“BZA”) hereby gives notice that the above-mentioned application, the subject property of which is located within the boundaries of your Advisory Neighborhood Commission, was filed with the BZA on August 1, 2011. A copy of the application is attached.

The application has been tentatively placed on the BZA’s Expedited Review Calendar for a decision without a public hearing at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C., 20001 on October 4, 2011, at 9:30 a.m. This is also the location of the Office of Zoning.

The ANC and the affected Single Member District may file a written request that the application be removed from the Expedited Review Calendar and heard by the BZA in accordance with 11 DCMR § 3117. Such a request must be filed with the Office of Zoning no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the date that the expedited review is scheduled, and must be accompanied by:

- (1) A statement indicating that an ANC representative will appear as a witness at the hearing; and
- (2) A summary of the testimony to be given at that time.

The BZA Chairperson may deny a request to remove an application if the proffered testimony is irrelevant.

- b. ANCs may file this form as long as the case record is open, if they wish to participate in a rulemaking case under § 3021.

For Board of Zoning Adjustment:

- a. ANCs must file this form at least seven (7) calendar days in advance of the hearing.
