SUMMARY ORDER

REVIEW BY THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR

The application was accompanied by a memorandum from the Zoning Administrator certifying the required relief.

The Board of Zoning Adjustment ("Board") provided proper and timely notice of the public hearing on this application by publication in the *D.C. Register*, and by mail to Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC") 4D and to owners of property within 200 feet of the site. The site of this application is located within the jurisdiction of ANC 4D, which is automatically a party to this application. ANC 4D submitted a letter expressing support for the application (Exhibit 28); however the letter did not meet the requirements for "great weight" set forth in 11 DCMR § 3115. The Office of Planning ("OP") submitted reports recommending conditional approval of the application. (Exhibits 27 and 32.) A letter from the D.C. Department of Transportation expressed "no objection" to the application. (Exhibit 26.)

As directed by 11 DCMR § 3119.2, the Board has required the Applicant to satisfy the burden of proving the elements that are necessary to establish the case pursuant to § 3104.1, for special exception relief under § 733. No parties appeared at the public hearing in opposition to this application. Accordingly, a decision by the Board to grant this application would not be adverse to any party.

Based upon the record before the Board and having given great weight to the OP report, the Board concludes that the Applicant has met the burden of proof, pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3104.1 and 733. By consensus, the Board has waived the requirements of § 733.4 related to brick enclosures and the Board concludes that the requested relief can be granted, being in harmony with the

general purpose and intent of the Zoning Regulations and Map. The Board further concludes that granting the requested relief will not tend to affect adversely the use of neighboring property in accordance with the Zoning Regulations and Map.

Pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3100.5, the Board has determined to waive the requirement of 11 DCMR § 3125.3, that the order of the Board be accompanied by findings of fact and conclusions of law. It is therefore **ORDERED** that this application is hereby **GRANTED, SUBJECT to the following CONDITION:**

1. The property owner shall construct and maintain a gated, pressure-treated, wooden stockade fence enclosing all trash and grease dumpsters located on the property.

PURSUANT TO 11 DCMR § 3125.9, NO ORDER OF THE BOARD SHALL TAKE EFFECT UNTIL TEN (10) DAYS AFTER IT BECOMES FINAL PURSUANT TO § 3125.6.

FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THE CONDITION IN THIS ORDER, IN WHOLE OR IN PART

SHALL BE GROUNDS FOR THE REVOCATION OF ANY BUILDING PERMIT OR CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS ORDER.

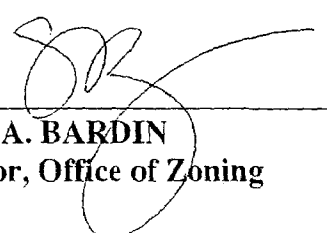

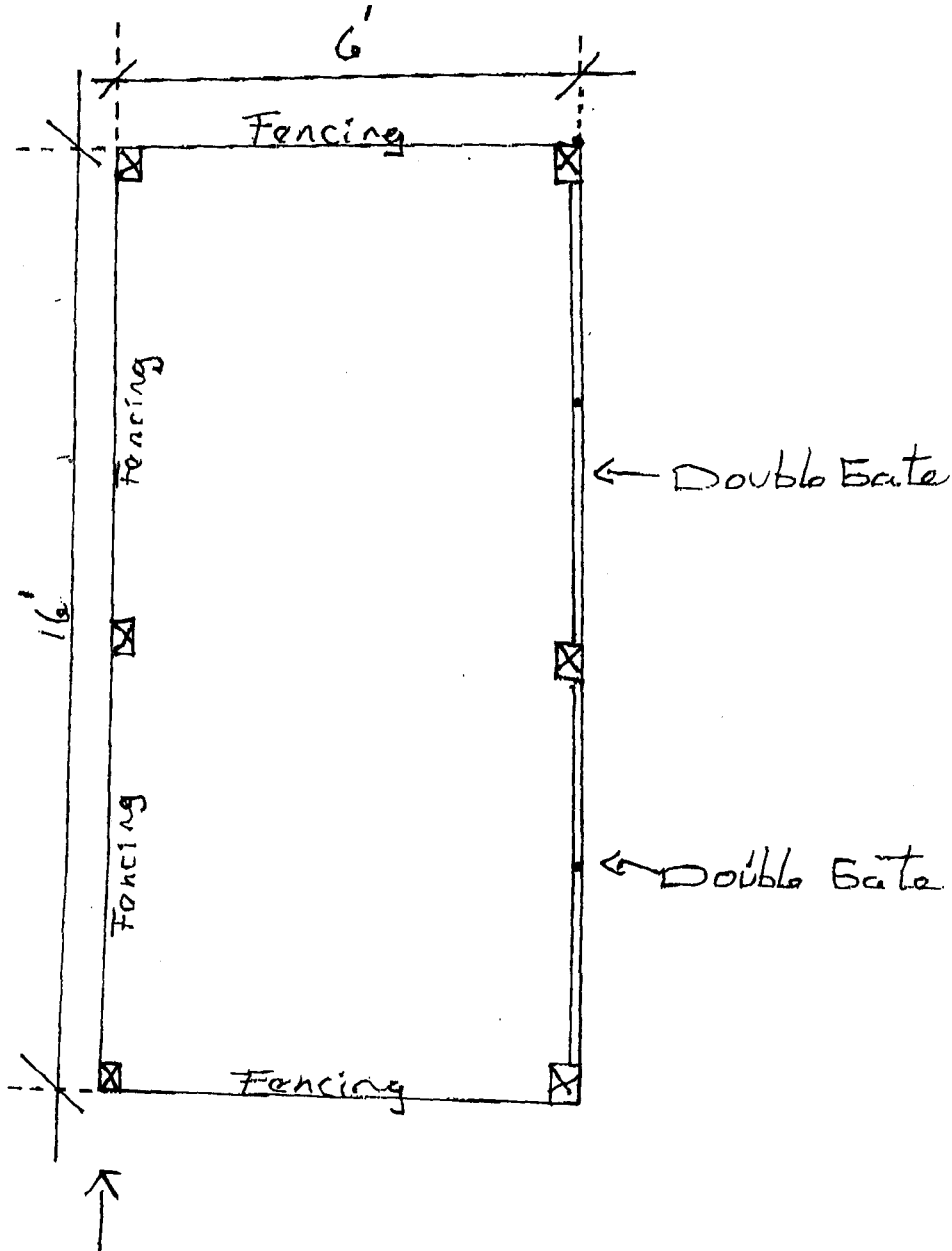

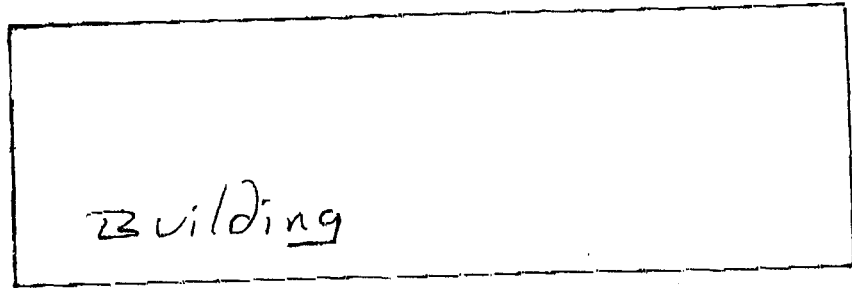
