Dear Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1A :

This is to advise you that a public hearing has been scheduled by the Board of Zoning Adjustment to consider the following application that is located within the boundaries of your ANC area:

Application of Jubilee Housing, Inc., pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3104.1, for a special exception to allow a child development center (80 infants and children and 15 staff) under section 205, and a special exception to allow a community service center serving 35 high school aged children under section 209, in the D/R-5-B District on the ground floor of premises 1474 Columbia Road, N.W. (Square 2669, Lot 825).

The hearing will be held on Tuesday, February 14, 2012, at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C. 20001. This application will be heard between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

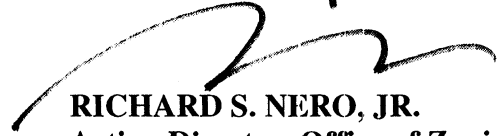
