

STATEMENT OF EXISTING AND INTENDED USES

Evermay was built as a residence in 1801-02, and is listed as both a local and national historic landmark. The main building contains in excess of 10,000 square feet of gross floor area. Formerly used as a residence, the property is presently vacant. The S&R Foundation proposes to use the property for non-profit organization purposes, pursuant to 11 DCMR, § 217, as well as residential quarters for the property owner.
