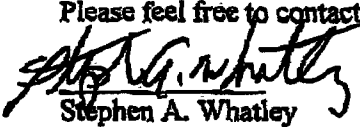
The applicant was in attendance and the applicant and residents were provided an opportunity to speak concerning this application at the meeting.

By a 7-0 vote, ANC 4A voted to recommend renewal of the special exception contingent upon the continuation of the voluntary neighborhood agreement between WES, nearby neighbors and the appropriate 4A Commissioners. In addition ANC 4A requests that WES be afforded the maximum amount of time allowed by law before the next renewal submission requirement.

The ANCs and the nearby community noted that WES has been a good neighbor and continues to meet with residents on a regular basis to resolve any issues as they may arise.

ANC 4A Commissioners Dwayne Toliver and Karl Kennedy are authorized by ANC 4A to represent ANC 4A in this matter.
