ANC 6C is hereby withdrawing appeal #18367.

At a regularly scheduled, properly noticed meeting on July 11, 2012, with a quorum of six (of eight) Commissioners present, ANC 6C voted 6-0-0 in favor of withdrawing its appeal provided that the ANC & The Crucible could agree on conditions of operation for The Crucible which would protect the safety and well-being of the neighborhood. In this same motion, the ANC designated Tony Goodman, the ANC Commissioner for 6C04, as its representative in this matter.

On July 13, 2012, Frazier Botsworth, the owner and representative of The Crucible and Tony Goodman, the designated representative for ANC 6C, came to an agreement which is satisfactory to both parties.
