To Whom It May Concern.

The D C. Office of Zoning is providing this letter to inform all property owners within 200 feet of a development project of conditions associated with the approval of the project

The following is offered for informational purposes only You are not required to respond or take any other action with respect to this letter. Further, the record in this case is closed and no additional documentation will be accepted.

The D C Board of Zoning Adjustment recently approved the following project, which is within 200 feet of your property.

**Application No. 18383 of Barbara Chambers Children's Center**, pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3104.1, for a special exception to permit the expansion (225 Children and 47 Staff) of an approved child development center (BZA Order No. 17731) under section 205, in the R-5-B District at premises 1470 Irving Street, N.W (Square 2672, Lot 881).

This application was approved subject to the following conditions

- 1 The hours of operation shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., with all persons off the site, including the parking lot, by 10:30 p.m.
- 2 The number of enrolled children shall not exceed 225.
- 3 The number of staff shall not exceed 47.
- 4 Outdoor activities shall be supervised and conclude by 8:00 p.m.
- 5 Trash receptacles shall be kept on site and collected three times a week, and the property shall be kept free of debris.
- 6 Staff shall monitor the dropping off and picking up of the children.
- 7 The parking lot shall be lit from sunset to sunrise.
- 8 Under the Transportation Demand Management (TDM) program recommended by the Department of Transportation, the Applicant shall implement the following transportation demand management measures
  - a) install a bicycle rack and announce its availability to staff, parents and visitors,

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- b) implement adjusted pick-up and drop-off plan as identified in the Application,
- c) join the WMATA SmartBenefits program, which enables pre-tax salary to be transferred directly to employee SmartTrip cards

**Please note:** The timeframe for development of an approved project varies depending on the scope and complexity of the project. Consequently, the conditions enumerated above may not be pertinent or at issue until a future date.
