PUBLIC HEARING—March 24, 1948

Mr. Clouser:

I move that the following Order be entered:

ORDERED:

That the appeal of the Hebrew Academy of Washington for permission to establish a private school at the southeast corner of 16th Street and Fort Stevens Drive, N.W., parcels 87/411, 87/412 and 87/401 (square 2726) be granted for the following reasons:

(1) As the result of an inspection of the property by the Board, and from the records and the evidence adduced at the hearing, the Board finds that the Hebrew Academy of Washington is a school within the meaning of the Zoning Regulations; that its space and equipment will not be readily convertible to business use; that it has no articles of commerce for sale; that its operation would be impaired by location on a business street because of the ages of contemplated pupils, and that it is not likely to become objectionable in this residential area because of noise, traffic, and number of students.

(2) There was no objection to the granting of this appeal registered at the public hearing.

Mr. Scrivener: I second the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
