Your applications have been accepted as complete. You are hereby notified to appear before the Board of Zoning Adjustment (Board) on Tuesday, September 25, 2012, at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C., 20001 for a public hearing concerning the following applications:

Application of Jewish Primary Day School of the Nation's Capital Inc., pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3103.2 and 3104.1, for a variance from the off-street parking requirements under subsection 2101.1, and a special exception under section 206 to increase the private school student enrollment cap from 125 to 130 students and to increase the faculty and staff cap from 15 to 26, in the R-1-B District at premises 4715 16th Street, N.W. (Square 2707, Lot 33); and,

Application of Jewish Primary Day School of the Nation's Capital Inc., pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3103.2 and 3104.1, for a variance from the off-street parking requirements under subsection 2101.1, and a special exception under section 206, to increase the student enrollment cap from 275 to 300 students and to increase the faculty and staff cap from 56 to 72, and to extend the private school campus boundaries to include additional property, in the R-1-B and R-5-A Districts at premises 6045 16th Street, N.W. (Square 2726, Lots 825 and 831).

The properties involved in these applications are located within the boundaries of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4C and 4A, respectively. These applications will be heard between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE THAT A SIGN(S) MUST BE OBTAINED FROM THE OFFICE OF ZONING TO BE POSTED ON THE PROPERTY. The Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure (11 DCMR §§ 3113.14 through 3113.20) provides that the notice sign must be posted at least 15 days prior to the hearing. The posted notice must also be checked at least once every five days, and replaced when necessary. An affidavit concerning the original posting of the sign must be filed with the Board at least 5 days prior to the hearing.
