Dear Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4A:

This is to advise you that a public hearing has been scheduled by the Board of Zoning Adjustment to consider the following application that is located within the boundaries of your ANC area:

Application of Jewish Primary Day School of the Nation's Capital Inc., pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3103.2 and 3104.1, for a variance from the off-street parking requirements under subsection 2101.1, and a special exception under section 206, to increase the student enrollment cap from 275 to 300 students and to increase the faculty and staff cap from 56 to 72, and to extend the private school campus boundaries to include additional property, in the R-1-B and R-5-A Districts at premises 6045 16th Street, N.W. (Square 2726, Lots 825 and 831).

The hearing will be held on Tuesday, September 25, 2012, at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C. 20001. This application will be heard between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

You are advised that 11 DCMR Section 3115.1 sets out certain requirements related to reports of ANCs, and specifically that Section 3115 requires that the written report of the ANC be filed with the Board at least seven days in advance of the hearing. - a. ANCs must file this form at least seven (7) calendar days in advance of the hearing, if they wish to participate in a contested case under § 3022.
- b. ANCs may file this form as long as the case record is open, if they wish to participate in a rulemaking case under § 3021.

For Board of Zoning Adjustment:

- a. ANCs must file this form at least seven (7) calendar days in advance of the hearing.
