This letter is to advise that Advisory Neighborhood Commission 7D, at its regularly scheduled public meeting held June 12, 2012, at which a quorum was present, voted (6-0-0) to support the above-referenced special request application to permit Mrs. Roslyn Taylor to operate a child development center for up to 12 children at her home located at 4428 Ord Street, NE (Square 5117, Lot 838).

Mrs. Taylor has been operating a licensed child care home for up to six children, known as Lia's Rainbow, LLC, since 2010. The child care center is open 23 hours; workers will be required to obtain all background checks; and the NAFCC accredited (Early Childcare Education accreditation). The facility serves an important role in support of working families in the Eastland Gardens and Kenilworth neighborhoods, and there is a lengthy waiting list of parents for Mrs. Taylor's child care programs.
