APPLICATION

Application of Massage Escape Spa Company, pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3104.1 and 1533.1, for a special exception for an massage establishment under section 731, in the NO/C-2-A and R-3 Districts at premises 2352 Wisconsin Avenue, N W (Square 1300, Lot 425).

RECOMENDATION

DDOT has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined that, based on the information provided, this proposed project will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. While an approved project may lead to more vehicular, transit, pedestrian, and bicycle trips, DDOT does not foresee additional trips to impact the network. Thus, DDOT has no objection to approval of the requested special exception.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. DDOT's lack of objection to the zoning special exception should not be viewed as approval of public space elements. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space, the Applicant may be required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. Guidance on the treatment of public space can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Manual.
