This is to advise you that a public hearing has been scheduled by the Board of Zoning Adjustment to consider the following appeal that is located within the boundaries of your ANC area:

Application of The National Presbyterian Church, pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3104.1 and 3103.2, for a special exception to allow the physical expansion of an existing private school to include a three story addition and increase in the student enrollment cap to 320 and the facility and staff cap to 70 individuals under section 206, and a variance from the side yard requirements for a temporary modular trailer under section 405, in the R-1-B District at premises 4120-4124 Van Ness Street, N.W. (Square 1724, Lot 805).

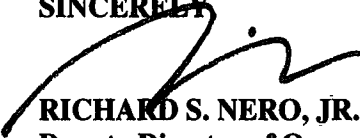
The hearing will be held on Tuesday, October 30, 2012, at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C. 20001. This appeal will be heard between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

You are advised that 11 DCMR Section 3115.1 sets out certain requirements related to reports of ANCs, and specifically that Section 3115 requires that the written report of the ANC be filed with the Board at least seven days in advance of the hearing.
