**Application of The Field School**, pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3104.1, for a special exception to increase the private school enrollment cap from 320 to 400 students and to increase the faculty and staff cap from 74 to 110 under section 206, in the R-1-A District at premises 2301 Foxhall Road, N W (Square 1341, Lots 856, 861, 878 and 879)

The property involved in this application is located within the boundaries of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3D. This application will be heard between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

An affidavit concerning the original posting of the sign must be filed with the Board at least 5 days prior to the hearing. The sign and the affidavit should be picked up from the Office of Zoning, Suite 200 South, 441 4<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. Please call the Office of Zoning in advance to order your sign(s) to assure that the sign(s) will be ready when you come to pick them up.

You should be aware that letters and other documents may be submitted to the Board by other individuals, organizations and government agencies both in support of and in opposition to your application. At least one week prior to the public hearing, you should review the file in your application so that you are prepared to respond to any issues that may be raised regarding your case.
