APPLICATION

Application of Daniel N. Howard, Jr. pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3104.1, for a special exception to allow a dental office as a home occupation with three (3) employees occupying the first floor under subsection 202.2(c), in the R-3 District at premises 641 G Street, S.W. (Square 467, Lot 212)

RECOMMENDATION

DDOT has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined that, based on the information provided, this proposed project will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. While an approved project may lead to more vehicular, transit, pedestrian, and bicycle trips, DDOT does not foresee impacts to travel conditions for the network.

The project has the potential to generate minor impacts to on-street parking conditions in the area. Vehicle parking demand may increase slightly as a result of the project, inducing a higher level of parking utilization in the immediate area. Despite this minor potential impact, DDOT has no objection to the approval of the requested special exception.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. DDOT's lack of objection to the zoning special exception should not be viewed as approval of public space elements. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space, the Applicant may be required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. Guidance on the treatment of public space can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Manual.
