N.E. Supplemental Report

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The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) reviewed the pedestrian and bicycle analysis submitted by the Applicant on December 10th, 2012 and created a work order to replace the identified missing traffic sign. No additional submittals have been received regarding the DDOT request for a pedestrian entrance off of 12th Street.

On December 20, 2012, the Public Space Committee (PSC) approved with conditions the rental parking as requested by the Applicant. Please find attached the decision letter. At the request of Commissioner Regina James, DDOT attended an SMD meeting on January 17th, 2012 to discuss DDOT's role in the BZA and Public Space Committee processes.

The below recommendations previously made in our report remain unchanged. DDOT does not expect that the proposal will adversely impact the surrounding transportation network with the condition that the Applicant completes the following pedestrian and bicycling measures to support their parking variance relief request:

- Install 1-2 inverted U-racks at the main entrance of each building; and
- Install a pedestrian entrance off of 12th Street.
