SUBJECT: BZA Case 18483, 1235 4th Street, N.W. (Square 0523, Lot 0023)

APPLICATION

Pursuant to 11 DCMR § 2101.1 and 11 DCMR § 3103.2, for a variance for the construction of a new two-family flat structure in the R-4 Zoning District, located at 1235 4th Street, N.W. (Square 0523, Lot 0023).

RECOMENDATION

DDOT has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined that, based on the information provided; this proposed project will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. While an approved project may lead to more vehicular, transit, pedestrian, and bicycle trips, DDOT does not foresee additional trips to impact the network. Thus, DDOT has no objection to approval of the requested area variance.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. DDOT's lack of objection to the zoning area variance should not be viewed as approval of public space elements. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space, the Applicant may be required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. Guidance on the treatment of public space can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Manual.
