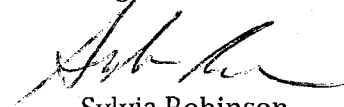
The development team for the Howard University Interdisciplinary Research Building returned to the Georgia Avenue Community Development Task Force (GACDTF) on Wednesday, February 27, 2013 to describe the additional special exception relief from the penthouse setback requirements they were requesting of the Board of Zoning Adjustment during their hearing on Tuesday March 5th.

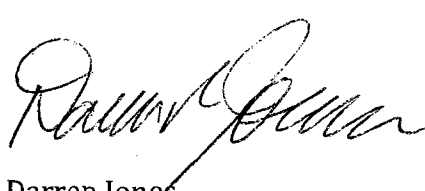
The group noted that this was the same design that was presented at the January 23rd GACDTF meeting, with a more detailed description of the roof structures, penthouse enclosures, the rules governing their setbacks and the departure from those rules represented in the design.

A unanimous vote in support of the current building's design took place among the GACDTF members in attendance, and the University was encouraged to proceed with the construction of this new addition to Georgia Avenue.

The GACDTF requests that the BZA approve the special exception relief from the penthouse setback requirements.
