This is to advise you that a public hearing has been scheduled by the Board of Zoning Adjustment to consider the following appeal that is located within the boundaries of your ANC area:

Appeal of Washington Harbour Condominium Unit Owner's Association, pursuant to 11 DCMR §§ 3100 and 3101, from a decision by the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs to issue a determination letter dated November 7, 2012, for construction of a new mixed use (residential, retail, office and inn) building in the W-2 and W-3 Districts at premises 3050 K Street, N.W. (Square 1173, Lot 102).

The hearing will be held on Tuesday, March 26, 2013, at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C. 20001. This appeal will be heard between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

You are advised that 11 DCMR Section 3115.1 sets out certain requirements related to reports of ANCs, and specifically that Section 3115 requires that the written report of the ANC be filed with the Board at least seven days in advance of the hearing.
