

Statement explaining how this application will meet zoning requirements.

This application meets zoning requirements because I live in a section 8 community which allows families up to 16 people to live in one residence. I'm currently operating a child development home of 6 children and have been licensed for 10 years. There is plenty of street parking during the day with two off street parking spaces in the rear. There are no residential parking restrictions to limit parents during drop off and pick-up times in the morning and evenings.

There is no on-site outdoor play area at the facility and we take daily nature walks to all play grounds. Outdoor play is limited to local school & recreation centers where high noise levels are acceptable. Childcare services will be provided during times where families are working so that the retired and elderly can still have minimal noise levels they are accustomed. There are 20,000 children in need of early care in the Washington, DC area. When I'm approved for expansion this will allow me to provide quality services to my neighbors, local families and DC residents. Also, this will provide positive impact on the city services and employment for DC residents while reducing and minimizing the need for childcare.
