APPLICATION

Pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3104 1, for a special exception under section 223, not meeting the lot occupancy (section 403), side yard (section 405) and nonconforming structure (subsection 2001.3) requirements for an addition to an existing one-family semi-detached dwelling in the R-4 District at premises 525 5th Street, S.E (Square 822, Lot 825)

RECOMENDATION

DDOT has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined that, based on the information provided, this proposed project will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. While an approved project may lead to more vehicular, transit, pedestrian, and bicycle trips, DDOT does not foresee additional trips to impact the network. Thus, DDOT has no objection to approval of the requested special exception

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space DDOT's lack of objection to the zoning special exception should not be viewed as approval of public space elements If any portion of the project has elements in the public space, the Applicant may be required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. Guidance on the treatment of public space can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Manual
