This is to advise you that a public hearing has been scheduled by the Board of Zoning Adjustment to consider the following appeal that is located within the boundaries of your ANC area:

Application of Christopher D. French and Anya Landau French, pursuant to 11 DCMR § 3103.2, for a variance from the floor area ratio requirements under section 402, a variance from the lot occupancy requirements under section 403, a variance from the rear yard requirements under section 404, and a variance from the nonconforming structure requirements under subsection 2001.3, to allow a third floor addition to an existing one-family row dwelling in the R-5-B District at premises 929 5th Street, S.E. (Square 824, Lot 31).

The hearing will be held on Tuesday, June 11, 2013, at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 220 South, Washington, D.C. 20001. This appeal will be heard at 9:30 a.m.

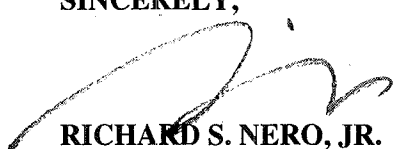
