This is to advise you that a public hearing has been scheduled by the Board of Zoning Adjustment to consider the following application that is located within the boundaries of your ANC area:

Application of Jaime Flood, pursuant to 11 DCMR § § 3104.2 and 3103.2, for a variance from the alley setback requirements under subsection 2300.2, and a special exception under section 223, to allow the construction of a carport at the rear of a row dwelling, not meeting the lot occupancy (section 403), and nonconforming structure (subsection 2001.3) provisions in the R-4 District at premises 803 9th Street, N.E. (Square 933, Lot 14).

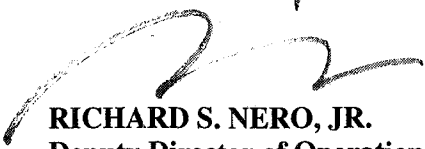
