APPLICATION

Pursuant to *Title 11 DCMR §§3104.2* the *Applicant* seeks a special exception to establish a pet grooming establishment under §736, in the C-2-A District at premises 4824 MacArthur Boulevard, N.W. (Square 1388, Lot 25)

ACTION

DDOT has reviewed the *Applicant's* request and determined, based on the information provided, the proposal will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. The project has the potential to generate minor impacts to on-street parking conditions in the area. Vehicle parking demand may increase slightly as a result of the project, resulting in a higher level of parking utilization in the immediate area. Despite this minor potential impact, DDOT has no objection to the approval of the special exception.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space, the *Applicant* may be required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. Guidance on the treatment of public space can be found in *DDOT's Public Realm Manual*.

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
