Since the initial hearing my health condition has taken a terrible turn for the worst and I am not able to get next door without assistance. Also the house has a large number of people there. they are very noisy, play loud music without respect to neighbors, running up/down steps, shouting all thruought the night interfering with my **quality** of sleep. I fear with the expansion of that huge deck that invades my personal space (they can see directly into my home), interferes with lighting and drainage. Unfortunately due to my most recent condition (I am supposed to actually be in a nursing home currently). I will not be able to attend future hearings despite my desire; I would still like to stay informed, participate and made aware of the situation. Please forgive my letter, I have neurological deficits and it took me 3 hrs to write with many corrections. Also may I take this moment to let you know that you have an outstanding employer wit Mr. Mr. Richard Nero Jr. The most considerate, compassionate, helpful and truly selfness individual I have had the pleasure to deal within the government system.
