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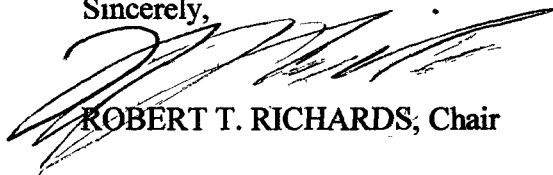
Re: BZA Application 18633 - 2826 Q Street, SE

At its regular Public meeting held following proper notice, the Commission held a review of the above application. Because the hour was getting late and many issues remained undiscussed and there was opposition and uncertainty on the nature of the exceptions and the intended temporary residential use, the commission and the applicant agreed that it would be in everyone's best interest to table the matter until the Commission's October Public meeting and that the applicant would ask the BZA to continue the upcoming hearing to allow for the Commission to further consider the matter and to take a vote.
