SUBJECT: BZA Case No. 18642 – 1210 Simms Place, N.E. (Square 4052, Lot 181)

APPLICATION

Pursuant to Title 11 DCMR §§3103.2, the Applicant seeks a variance from the lot occupancy (722.1), rear yard (774.1) and off-street parking requirements (§§2101.1) to construct an four (4) unit apartment house in the C-2-A District at premises 1210 Simms Place, N.E. (Square 4052, Lot 181)

ACTION

DDOT has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined, based on the information provided, the proposal will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. The project has the potential to generate minor impacts to on-street parking conditions in the area. Vehicle parking demand may increase slightly as a result of the project, resulting in a higher level of parking utilization in the immediate area. Despite this minor potential impact, DDOT has no objection to the approval of the variance.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space, the Applicant may be required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. Guidance on the treatment of public space can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Manual

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
