SUBJECT: BZA Case No. 18661 – 405 8th Street, SE (Square 902, Lot 825)

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APPLICATION

Pursuant to Title 11 DCMR §§3103.2, the Applicant seeks variances from the rear yard (§774) and off-street parking requirements (§2001.1 & §2104) to allow construction of a rear addition to an existing commercial building in the CHC/C-2-A District at premises 405 8th Street, SE (Square 902, Lot 825)

RECOMMENDATION

DDOT has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined, based on the information provided, the proposal will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. DDOT has no objection to the approval of the requested variances.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space, the Applicant may be required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. Guidance on the treatment of public space can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Manual.

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
