SUBJECT: BZA Case No. 18669 – 4824 MacArthur Boulevard, N.W. (Square 1388, Lot 25)

APPLICATION

Pursuant to Title 11 DCMR §3104.2 the Applicant seeks a special exception to establish a dog boarding establishment under §735 in the R-1-B District at premises 4824 MacArthur Boulevard, N.W. (Square 1388, Lot 25)

The Applicant seeks to expand the existing dog grooming business approved in BZA Order No. 18572 by adding a dog boarding program. The proposed dog boarding operation will occupy the basement level of the building and no exterior improvements are proposed.

RECOMMENDATION

DDOT has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined, based on the information provided, the proposal will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. DDOT has no objection to the approval of the requested special exception

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space, the Applicant may be required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. Guidance on the treatment of public space can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Manual.
