I am writing this letter in response to one I received last Saturday, January 11, 2014, from the ANC 7B Commissioner regarding my application for an exemption in an R-2 district, to establish a child development center, for 15 children and 3 staff.

On December 17, 2013, the Board handed down its ruling in this case. All parties had ample opportunity to respond. The request of the ANC 7B to have this case reopened would pose a significant hardship on me and my ability to get this business up and running. I must obtain a Certificate of Occupancy from DCRA, which I must then submit to OSSE for my application to move forward through the next steps. Asking that I come down for another hearing will take time away from this most important process.

I am asking the Board to please consider the significant hardship reopening this case would impose on me, a small business owner, trying to establish a much needed service in the Ward 7 community.
