We just finished meeting with a representative from TransitScreen and I found out some additional information regarding the program

The system has an initial set up cost of \$2,000 00 and a service fee of \$50.00 per month or \$600 00 per year A five year commitment will cost approximately \$5,000.00 Those fees do not include the TV or computer screens or the cost to make an existing TV web-enabled which costs around \$100.00

The company needs about a month lead time after receiving a client request and it takes only a few hours to set up (less than an hour for our building)
