Dear Board of Zoning Adjustment:

I am writing in my capacity as Single Member District Commissioner of ANC3C08 to urge that the Maret School BZA Application #18715 be granted without reservation or condition. Maret has held a series of neighborhood meetings and no objections have been expressed to the plan. ANC3C has passed Resolution 2013- 045 in support of this application which, as you know, is entitled to great weight.

I have been an ANC Commissioner for eight years and Maret School is located in my single member district. During my time on the ANC, Maret has been an exemplary neighbor. The school has worked closely with neighborhood groups and individuals to ensure that the school remains sensitive to neighborhood concerns. During this time the neighborhood has not experienced an increase in traffic or parking problems and I have not received any complaints about Maret School.

Maret School has worked diligently to minimize traffic and parking issues and in my tenure there have been very few concerns expressed about the school's traffic and parking operations. The school does a good job of communicating with the Woodley Park Citizens Association and other neighborhood leaders. As a matter of practice, it has held meetings with neighbors to update them on school plans/operations and to invite neighbors

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to express any concerns. The school does a good job managing traffic and parking operations.

Maret School is a valuable asset to the neighborhood and we want the school to continue to thrive. This proposal is modest, well thought through, and well vetted by the community. Accordingly we ask that the application be granted without reservation or condition.
