I live in the Dupont Circle neighborhood five blocks from the Andrew Keegan Theatre and am proud to be a member of the board of this theatre that does so much and brings so much to the community. I urge you to grant the theater the adjustment required on the Certificate of Occupancy so that it can make important facility renovations and continue being a community asset.

Keegan Theatre enjoys tremendous neighborhood and community support. Residents of Church St on which the theater is located have been involved in and supportive of the renovation planning process and have even held a garage sale to raise money to support the renovation. Local organizations such as the Dupont Circle Village and Dupont Circle Citizens Association have indicated their support for the renovations and the theater through letters of support and a grant. The theater, in turn, offers very affordable ticket prices, provides senior discounts and discounts to these organizations, donates tickets to nonprofit organizations for their fundraising events, holds special events for the community and performs in Dupont Circle as part of the Dupont Festival. In addition, the theater has been supportive of the local school and youth activities in the area.

Mark and Susan Rhea, the co-artistic directors, are very focused on supporting the neighborhood and including community members in the renovation process and theater activities.
