2.	What legal interest does the person have in the property? (i.e. owner, tenant, trustee, or mortgagee)	Owner
3.	What is the distance between the person's property and the property that is the subject of the application before the Commission/Board? (Preferably no farther than 200 ft.)	40 ft.
4.	What are the environmental, economic, or social impacts that are likely to affect the person and/or the person's property if the action requested of the Commission/Board is approved or denied?	Trash/noise/increase carbon foot print; decrease property value/zero value of former home; potential crowding of local school.
5.	Describe any other relevant matters that demonstrate how the person will likely be affected or aggrieved if the action requested of the Commission/Board is approved or denied.	decrease parking for existing home owner/pollution in alley/overcrowding of public transportation.
6.	Explain how the person's interest will be more significantly, distinctively, or uniquely affected in character or kind by the proposed zoning action than that of other persons in the general public.	Increase in unknown transient tenants with vicinity to elementary school and decrease in appeal and value of my home next to multi unit apartment building.
