

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Attach photograph showing the Zoning Sign as seen from the public street in the space provided on the face of the affidavit. If more than one photograph is required, they should be mounted on a separate sheet of paper the same size as this form. The paper holding the photographs is to be firmly attached to this form.
2. All photographs must be at least three inches by three inches (3"x3") and numbered to correspond to the street frontages listed on the face of the affidavit.
3. Please refer to §§ 3015.4 through 3015.9 of Title 11 DCMR – Zoning (Rules of Practice and Procedure before the Zoning Commission of the District of Columbia) for the requirements regarding posting of the property.
4. Please ensure that this form is notarized and presented to the Office of Zoning at 441 4th Street, N.W., Suite 200-S, Washington, D.C. 20001.
