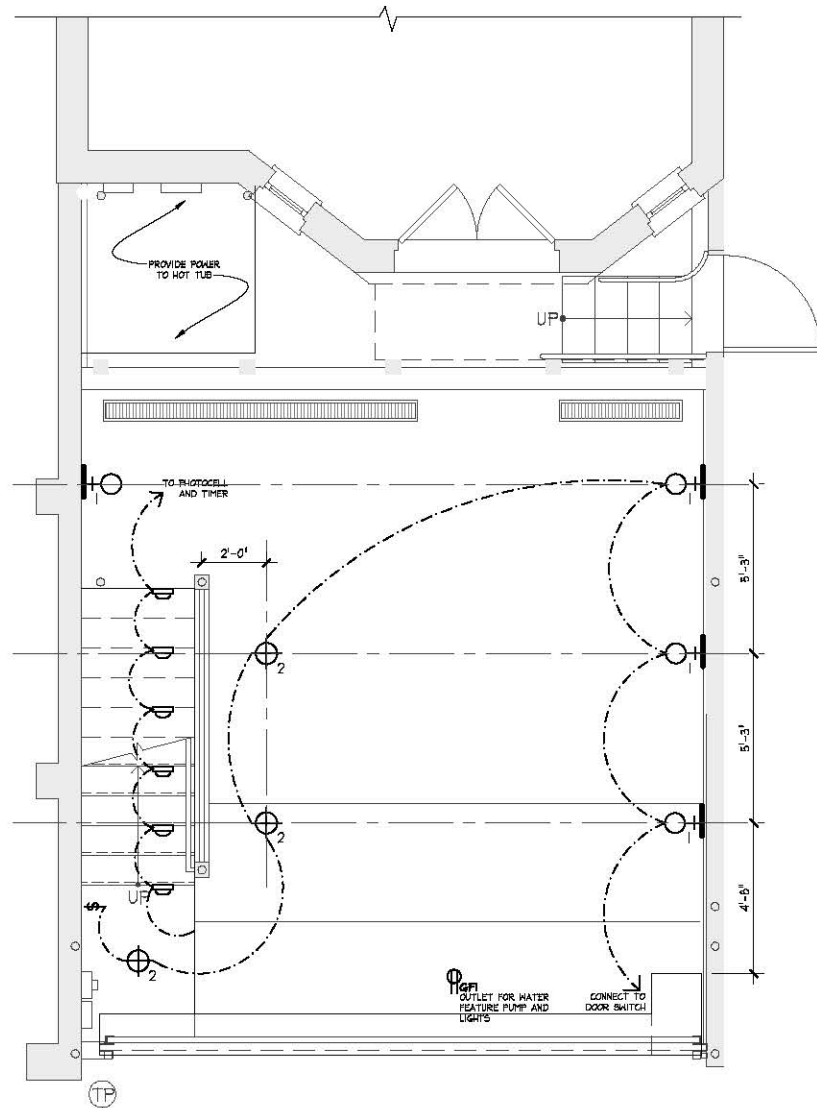
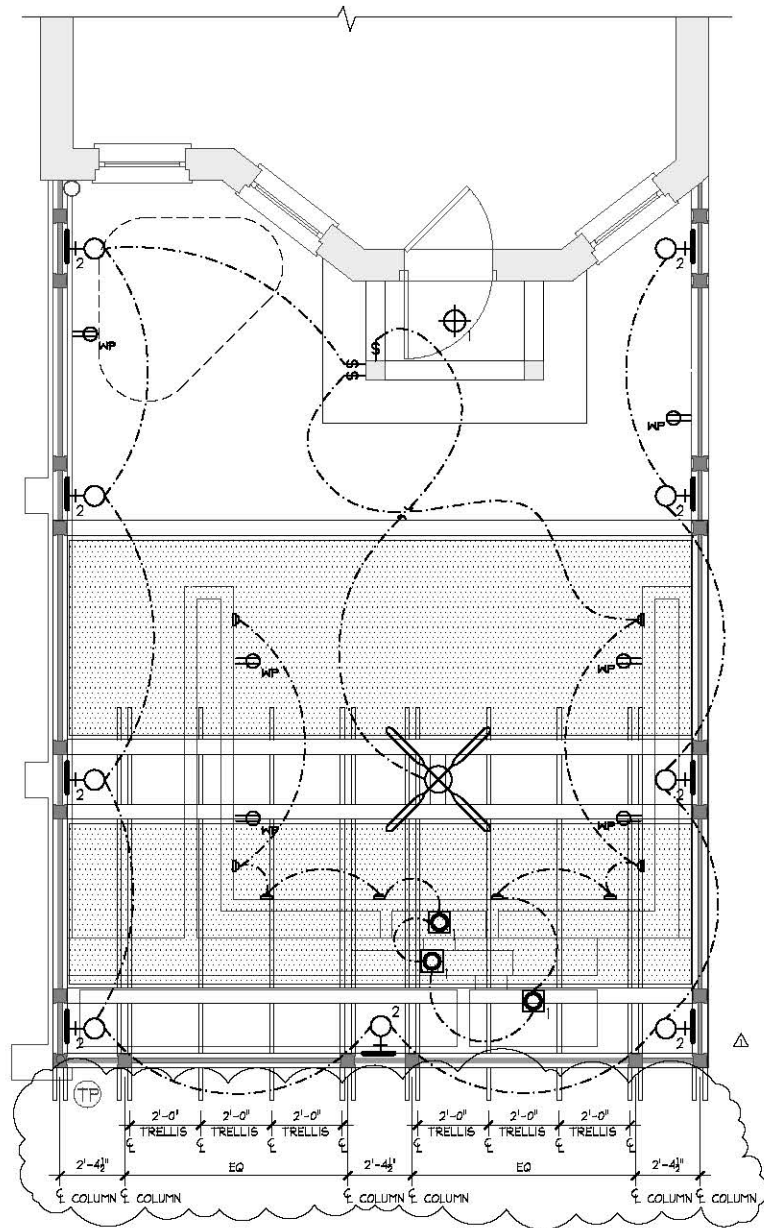




2 REFLECTED CEILING PLAN - PARKING
