Dear Ms. Ogbenna:

It has come to the attention of the Department of Health, Health Regulation and Licensing Administration, that you may be providing services as an assisted living residence or a community residence facility in the District of Columbia. In order to lawfully provide such services in the District of Columbia you must be licensed to operate as an assisted living residence or a community residence facility in accordance with the Assisted Living Residence Regulatory Act of 2000 (D.C. Law 13-127; D.C. Official Code § 44-101) or the Health-Care, Community Residence Facility, Home Care and Licensure Act of 1983 (D.C. Law 5-48; D.C. Official Code § 44-502), as appropriate.

If you are operating as an assisted living residence or community residence facility in the District of Columbia without a license you are advised to immediately cease and desist all unlicensed activity upon your receipt of this notice. Operating as a health care facility without a license may result in the imposition of civil fines, criminal prosecution or the initiation of injunctive relief.
