

Summary of Communications with the ANC

Because the emails included in the IZIS case file as PDFs are lengthy to read, please find below a condensed summary of my contacts with the ANC concerning our case.

1. Spoke to my ANC rep in person in July; was advised that she was about to resign her post but would get me on the agenda for their Sept meeting. On her instructions, collected signatures in support from neighbors
2. Spoke to ANC Chairwoman by phone in August to confirm that I was on the agenda for the Sept meeting and that she could see the plans and everything else on IZIS.
3. Arrived at meeting in Sept and confirmed I was on agenda, was called aside by Chairwoman during the meeting and told that she was not familiar with the case and felt it had nothing to do with the people in attendance. I understood she would look at it online and follow up with a letter of support or with concerns, if any. Gave her the signatures and left the meeting.
4. Followed up that night with email on what I had learned about the ANC part of this process, which I had researched online, including links, pasted text, and offers of additional information or action.
5. Followed up the next day, attaching the required form, which I had obtained from Tracey Rose at OZ because the link on the site to the form was broken.
6. Wrote again a few days later (Sept 28) asking for confirmation that she received my email and asking for her advice given that the form required a vote at a meeting and the next meeting was not in time for the deadline for filing the form. Verified that I was using the correct address, per thread in which she had replied from that address to others. (See from Shirley Smith Aug 12)
7. As of Oct 15, have not received any replies.
