
Re: BZA Appeal No. 18857 – Letter in Support of DCRA’s Motion to Dismiss Appeal as Moot


Dear Chairman Jordan and Members of the Board:

As noted in the Motion, the Zoning Commission approved AU’s minor modification application (ZC Case No. 11-07C) on February 2, 2015 by a vote of 5-0-0. 
