SUBJECT: BZA Case No. 18885 – 1401 Massachusetts Avenue, S.E. (Square 1059-S, Lot 11)

APPLICATION

Pursuant to 11 DCMR §§3104.1 and §§3103.2 Amanda Thomas (the Applicant) seeks special exceptions under §223 from the minimum lot dimension (§§401.1), lot occupancy (§§403.2), rear yard (§§404.1) and court width (§§406.1) requirements and a variance from the alley setback requirements (§§2300.2) to allow the enlargement of an existing deck and accessory garage to a single family dwelling in the R-4 District at premises 1401 Massachusetts Avenue, S.E. (Square 1059-S, Lot 11)

RECOMMENDATION

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined, based on the information provided, the proposal will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. DDOT has no objection to the approval of the requested special exception and variance.

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. DDOT's lack of objection to the zoning special exception and variance should not be viewed as an approval of public space elements. If any portion of the project has

elements in the public space requiring approval, the Applicant is required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. The Applicant may refer to the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations and DDOT's Design and Engineering Manual for specific controls of public space. A summary can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Design Manual.

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
