

Please support the Carnegie request for a one month extension of the Ingleside hearing.

This proposed expansion is environmentally inappropriate for the national park adjacent location. Construction will seriously disrupt quality of life for all surrounding neighbors for years. If completed, the expanded facility will bring much additional traffic and congestion to this quiet single family home neighborhood and wildlife refuge.

There will be blasting, loud noise, dirt and dust -- 6 days a week for 4 years.

Ingleside has manipulated the construction time from 4 to 3 years simply by not counting the whole project at once, but in stages.

They have stated they will immediately start construction on a house at the south end of their property when the major construction is complete.

They have refused to commit in writing to an agreed 20 year moratorium on construction in the ravine on the east side of their property.

An enforceable moratorium should be for 50 years.

They must guarantee in writing not pursuing the construction of another driveway on Military Road.

They must agree in writing not to purchase additional nearby single family homes.

They have financial situations that should be investigated and made part of the record. They contribute very little to the DC tax base and apparently owe \$millions they are supposed

to repay to DC. They are a non profit but their parent company WISC is an aggressive growth corporation which will profit hugely from this inappropriate intrusion on our neighborhood.

This is not a matter of right project. We count on the BZA to protect our right to quality of life.
