Honorable Members of the Board:

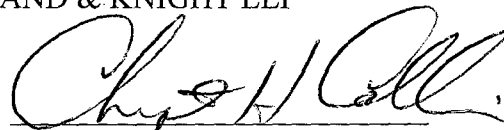
