SUBJECT: BZA Case No. 18931 – 721 11th Street, N.E. (Square 982, Lot 39)

APPLICATION

Pursuant to 11 DCMR §§3104.1 Carolina Lopez and Jeffrey Frank, the Applicants, seek a special exception under §223 from the lot occupancy (403.2), rear yard setback (§§404.1), open court (§§406.1) and nonconforming structure (§§2001.3) requirements to convert an existing two-story garage into a second-story apartment and construct a covered walkway in the R-4 District at premises 721 11th Street, N.E. (Square 982, Lot 39)

The Applicant may require additional Zoning relief from the alley setback requirements. The proposed new private garage is located 5 ft. from the centerline of the alley and does not comply with the minimum 12 ft. setback listed under §§2300.2 (b).

RECOMMENDATION

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has reviewed the Applicant's request and determined, based on the information provided, the proposal will have no adverse impacts on the travel conditions of the District's transportation network. DDOT has no objection to the approval of the special exception

This review pertains only to zoning issues and does not consider potential impacts to District owned public space. If any portion of the project has elements in the public space requiring approval, the Applicant is required to pursue a public space permit through DDOT's permitting process. The Applicant may refer to the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations and DDOT's Design and Engineering Manual for specific controls of public space. A summary can be found in DDOT's Public Realm Design Manual.

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
